



New Prep Sinks Get the Stylish Treatment from Native Trails

Prep sinks have their place in the kitchen, often as the utilitarian hub of a secondary workstation. Today, that can be the first place for developing a kitchen's aesthetic side. Two new designs from Native Trails - Cabana and Fiesta - can do just that, adding a singularly stylish point to the décor.

Cabana and Fiesta are the latest examples of the ingenious marriage of material and shape that has earned Native Trails a reputation for innovation in copper. Cabana was inspired by the very popular farmhouse sink and has been brought down to size for a prep or bar area. Fiesta is an apron-front sink with a curve thrown in, injecting an eye-catching note of circular geometry that extends beyond a counter's edge.

Cabana, as its name might suggest, is an ideal selection as well for a pool house or outdoor kitchen. Equally serviceable inside and out, the sink is 18 inches across the front by 16 inches and 7.5 inches deep. Fiesta is ample, too, at 16 inches across (inside dimension). Also 7.5 inches deep, Fiesta features a flat bottom, making it ideal for holding glasses and bottles when used as a bar sink. Both are available in Antique and Brushed Nickel. Both finishes reveal the thousands of hammer hits that shape every Native Trails sink and add textural interest as well as artisanal artistry to every kitchen.
