Native Trails Offers 40" Sinks Artisan Crafted in Copper and Brushed Nickel

Two new sinks from Native Trails being launched at KBIS 2008 are tailor made for the marketplace's hottest trends. The company's new 40-inch commercial sized sinks – the Farmhouse Duet Pro and Cocina Duet Pro - are right in step with the ever-expanding kitchen in the high-end sector. These new designs, artisan crafted in copper and offered in a richly hued copper finish as well as a jewel-like brushed nickel, also meet the growing desire for individualized style. The marriage of material, artistry and size certainly make these latest creations from Native Trails statement makers for any kitchen.

Besides their generous proportions, the two new double-basin sinks are intelligently designed. The large 24' x 18.5" main basins easily accommodate large pans. Native Trails has wisely lowered the divider a full two inches below the top edge to make shifting items from one basin to the next easier. Another detail with lots of contemporary appeal is the clean-edges styling of both designs.

Native Trails also introduces the Bistro sink, another design that plays right to the popularity of undermount sinks. At 24" x 18", it is more compact to fit smaller kitchens, or perhaps a guesthouse or outdoor kitchen. In large kitchens, Bistro is an excellent option as a second sink.

All three new designs are offered in Antique and Brushed Nickel. Suggested retail prices are: Farmhouse Duet Pro, Antique \$4,625, Brushed Nickel \$5,985; Cocina Duet Pro, Antique \$3,788, Brushed Nickel \$4,988 and the Bistro, Antique \$1,685, Brushed Nickel \$2,485.

Each Native Trails sink is crafted by artisans in Central Mexico with the techniques and tools handed down through generations. These hand-shaped, hand-hammered sinks have a very modern twist – they are made from recycled telephone wire and copper tubing, salvaged and then melted down into new sheets of copper ready for their second life as beautiful Native Trails sinks.
