Native Trails debuts Savannah Vanity in Walnut for 2011

The Savannah in walnut is the second iteration of the popular vanity style for Native Trails. Like the spring 2010 debut piece made from FSC wood and tailored to cottage-home style with a distressed, antique white finish, the Savannah in a rich, brown, FSC certified walnut is also hand-crafted by local artisans.

A sleek and petite luxury bathroom piece, the Savannah boasts simple lined cuts, four-post tapered legs, and a front-facing drawer accented with a recycled, clear glass knob and Blum soft-close drawer glides. The vanity runs 30"w x 21.5"d x 34"h.

"The Savannah was designed to adapt to classic and contemporary spaces with realistic dimensions for modern living" says Naomi Neilson Howard, CEO, founder, and design lead at Native Trails. "The intention is to maximize sophistication and functionality without sacrificing beauty, and to keep true to the tenants of green building."

The Savannah is an ideal foundation piece and intended to coordinate perfectly with Native Trails' inventory of marble, granite, or copper vanity tops and signature sinks, all hand-hammered from recycled copper and available in classic finishes or in brushed nickel to transform any washroom into a subtle statement-maker. Carrara marble, a lightly polished Italian marble, has been added to the line of stone vanity tops giving Native Trails vanities a sophisticated touch.
