

Zuma MAKING ANGLES



Native Trails offers a new slant on the kitchen sink with Zuma, a contemporary interpretation of the classic farmhouse style. Its angled front gives an unexpected perspective to the kitchen. The new design for 2009 hints at the commercial kitchen look with its wide open basin and angular shape, yet its richly textured surface adds warmth and design versatility. It is a statement-making sink that slips as easily into sleek modern décor as it does a more traditional setting.

Zuma has a generous-sized single basin and is handcrafted of recycled copper. It is available in two finishes, Antique and Brushed Nickel, both of which amply enhance the surface detail that distinguishes a Native Trails sink. Outside dimensions measure 33" x 22" x 10.5".

Every Native Trails sink is made by artisans using centuries old methods passed down through generations of coppersmiths in Central Mexico. Though the techniques are long-established, this new design proves that innovative thinking combines beautifully with tradition to give new shape to copper and kitchen design.
